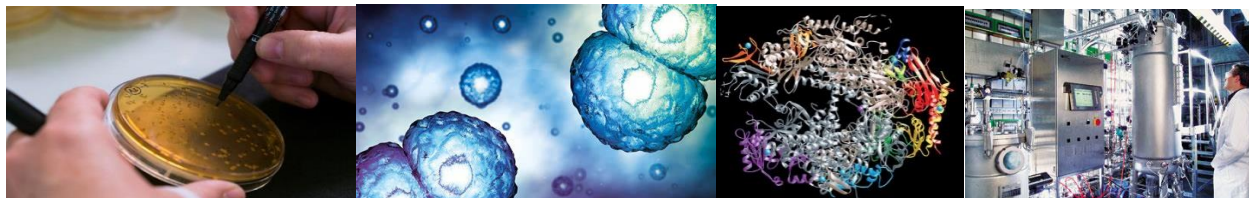


ENZYMATIC BIOCATALYSIS FOR INDUSTRY

New challenges and applications



Enzymatic biocatalysis has found an increased usage in a number of applications in various industrial segments, as an alternative or complement to chemical catalysis: pharmaceuticals, fragrances, specialty chemicals, biofuels, green chemistry, animal food and many others. Following Adebitech's successful Enzynov' conference of 2014 ([ENZINOV](http://ENZINOV.adebiotech.org) adebiotech.org), this new event will illustrate examples of applications of enzymatic biocatalysis, with a focus on scalable technologies. European partnerships between academia and industry will also be presented.
